OPERATING CONDITIONS (GENERAL DETAILS)

Authorisation is granted for ARTC Track Machines to occupy the Berrima Junction Up Arrival Road during the times specified above. The machines will be intermittently stabled, including Tamper TDX102 and Regulator BX102, and may be left unattended.

SAFEWORKING ARRANGEMENTS

The Track Machines are permitted to be left unattended in accordance with the following instructions:

Before the Rail Traffic Crew departs, they must:

- Ensure that 187 Points have been returned to the normal position, and after authority has been obtained from the Network Controller, are secured using point clips and SL locks,
- Ensure that 100% of handbrakes are applied on all Track Machines.

The Network Controller must:

- Ensure that 187 Points have been secured in the normal position using point clips and SL locks,
- Apply Blocking Facilities to the Up Arrival Road, the 187 Points and the 83 86 Point Indicators,
- Record an appropriate entry on the Train Control Graph detailing the Track Machines as stabled on the Up Arrival Road, and
- Ensure that the entry is carried over onto the subsequent Train Control Graphs until the Track Machines depart.

Preparation of Track Machines in readiness for each departure movement.

- Until authority is given by the Network Controller, the Rail Traffic Crew must not remove the point clips and SL locks from 187 Points at Berrima Junction.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

The stabling must be carried out as per the appropriate ARTC Network Rules and Procedures.

Recipients must ensure this Notice is circulated to and understood by all personnel affected by, or needing to know, its content. This Notice must be issued to all affected Competent Workers. Competent Workers who receive this Notice must follow the requirements.
